## STRUC-TIVISM



Constructivist art originated in Russia in 1915 by **Vladimir Tatlin** and **Alexander Rodchenko** at the start of the Russia Revolution. The Russian Revolution was a period of political and social revolution that took place in the former Russian Empire which began during the First World War. This period saw Russia abolish its monarchy and adopt a socialist form of government.

Constructivist art had a **great effect on modern art movements of the 20th century,** influencing major trends such as the Bauhaus movement. Its influence was widespread, with major effects upon architecture, sculpture, graphic design, industrial design, theatre, film, dance, fashion and, to some extent, music.















