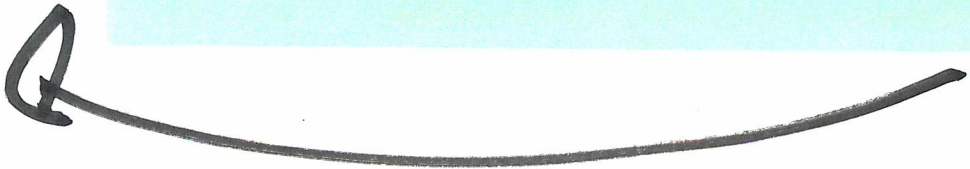
② Come up with this because: everyone said "DON'T DO ETC"

→ STOPPED searching for critiques specifically, looked at theories.

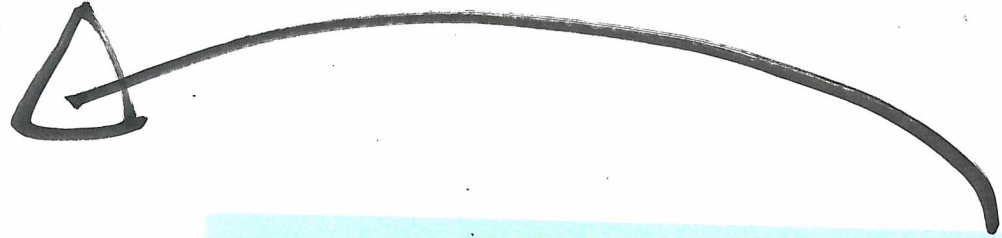
Simone de Beauvoir: male within females

Come with the Wind's Scarlett - seems almost GENDERLESS.

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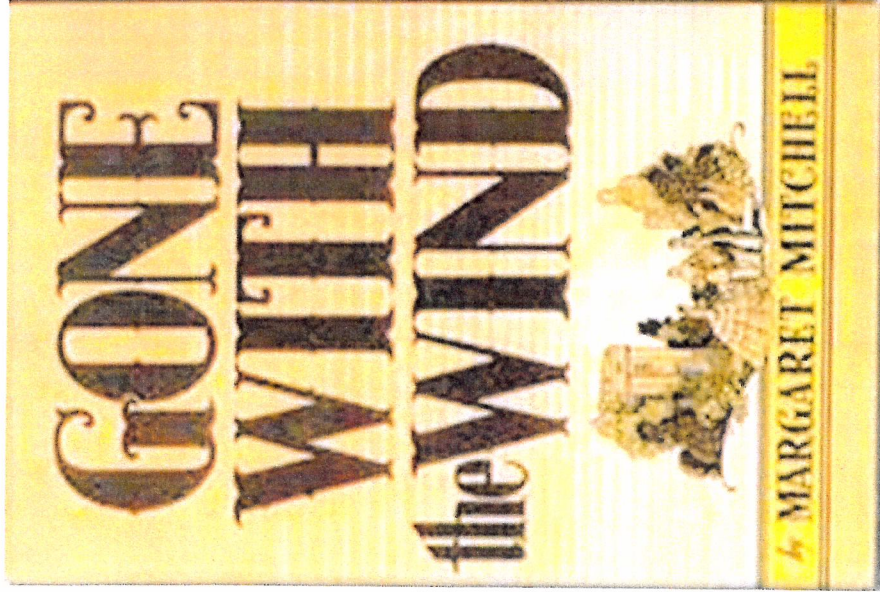


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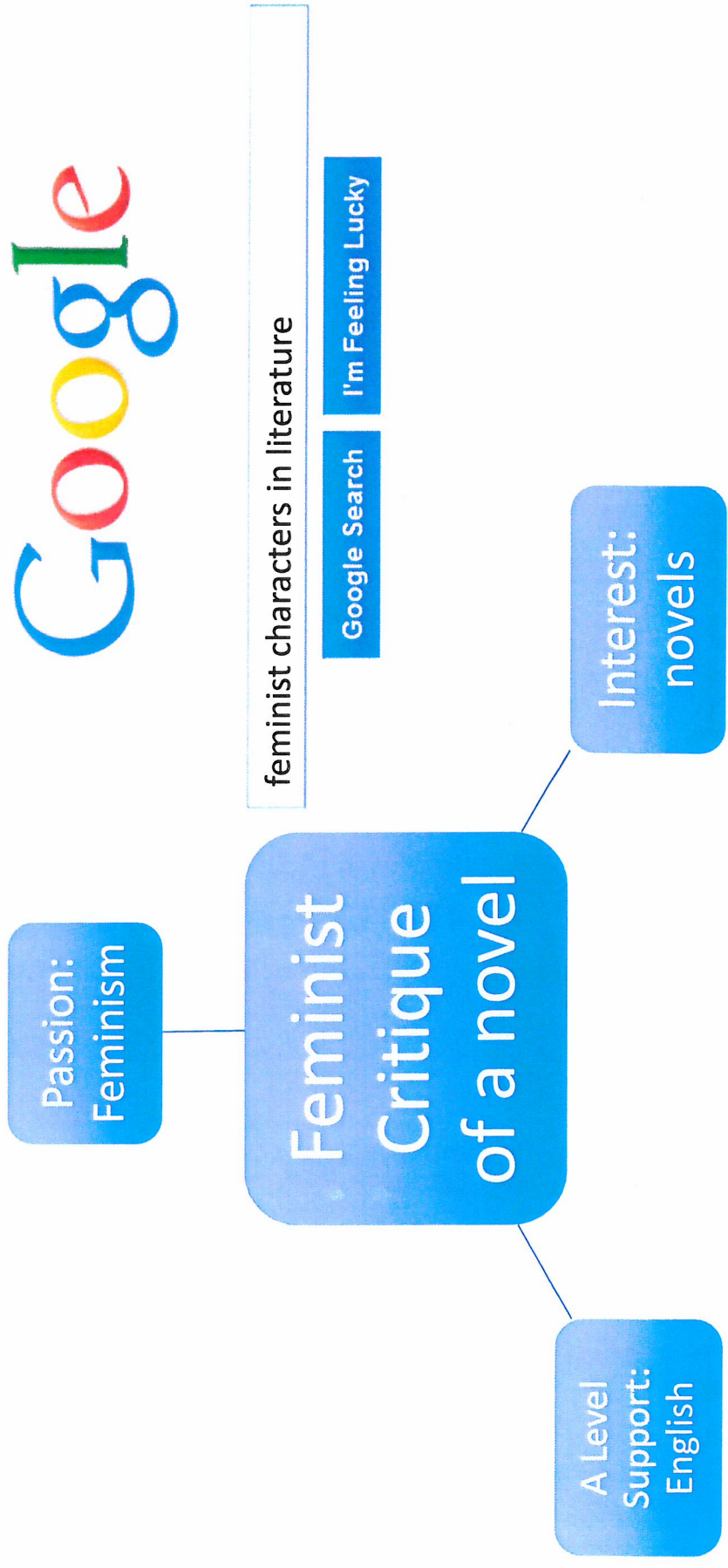

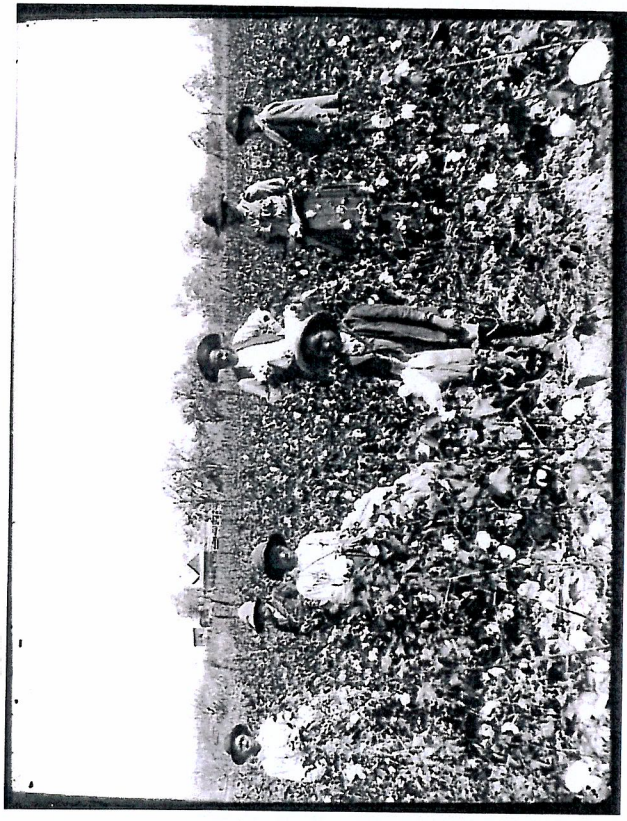
