9. Why does Emilia repeat "my husband" several times?
10. Once Emilia realises what has happened, she considers herself relieved of her marital obligations: find the quote that shows this?
11. What does Emilia say to Othello next? Why are these words important?
12. Why does Iago kill Emilia?
13. How does Montano describe Othello?
14. What does Emilia sing as she dies?
