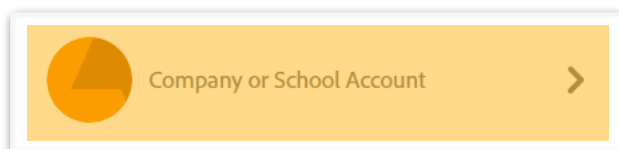


# How to install Adobe programs on your personal devices

## Create your Adobe College account

- Go to <https://creativecloud.adobe.com>
- Type in your College email address ([xxx@godalming.ac.uk](mailto:xxx@godalming.ac.uk))
- Click 'company or school account'
- **Do not type in a password**
- Click 'reset your password'
- **Do not close the window**

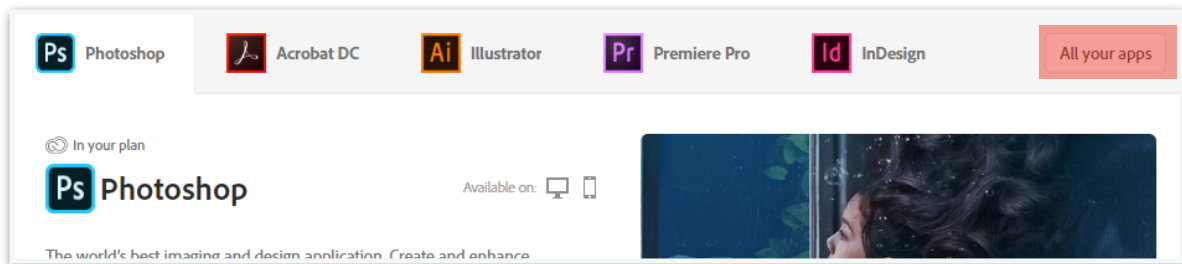

## Set your password

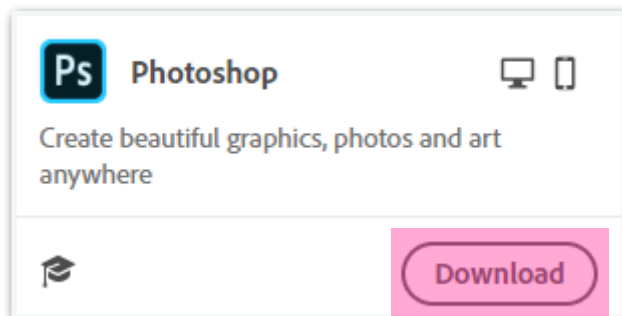
- An email will be sent to your college account with a 6-digit number
- Enter the number into box in the window you left open
- Choose a password containing uppercase, lowercase, numbers, symbol, and at least 8 characters
- An email will be sent to confirm you have changed your password

## Download your app installers

- You will now be logged in to Creative Cloud
- Click 'all your apps' on the top bar



- Click 'download' on the program you want



## Install your apps

- Wait for the download to finish and run the install
- The installer will ask you to authenticate your account, click continue
- Log in to the website using your college email address and the password you just set up
- Once you have authenticated your account the installer will ask you for a few questions that are specific to you
- The installer will now download and install your program
