Where in Somerwall would you locate the following businesses? The eight possible sites are identified by the numbers 1-8 on the following map. Each location should be used once only.

- a farmer (needs arable land)
- b pottery (needs to attract tourists)
- c fisherman (needs a port, but low costs)
- d fashion retailer (needs to be in a main shopping centre)
- e caravan park (needs to be close to tourists, but on cheaper land if possible)
- f garden centre (needs to be on a main road, close to centres of population)
- g restaurant for tourists
- h warehouse for computing equipment

Task 2

Identify those places where a *hotel* could be sited. Explain the largest markets for your hotels and the reasons for the chosen location.

Additional notes:

- The most expensive land is in the tourist area and the larger towns.
- The tourist area between W and X has the vast majority of tourist restaurants.
- Land becomes cheaper as you move away from the coastline.
- The most arable land is close to the water.
