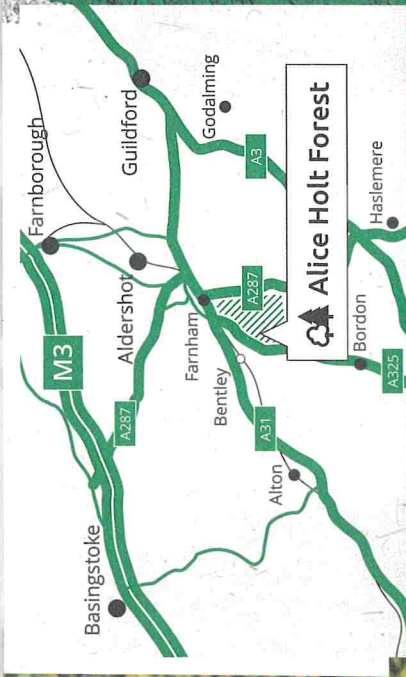

Waymarked trails

Timberline Trail ●●●
0.5 km (0.3 miles)

A family walk with play structures leading to the Habitat Trail.

Habitat Trail ●●●
1 km (0.6 miles)

A family walk with giant play sculptures.

Willows Green Trail ●●●
1 km (0.6 miles)

An attractive trail with one steep section and an optional shorter route.

Easy Access Trail ●●●
2 km (1.5 miles)

Suitable for wheelchair and pushchair users, this trail takes you through a variety of woodland and has an optional shortcut.

Lodge Pond Trail ●●●
4 km (2.5 miles)

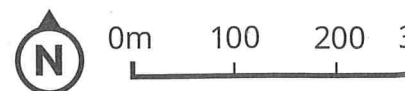
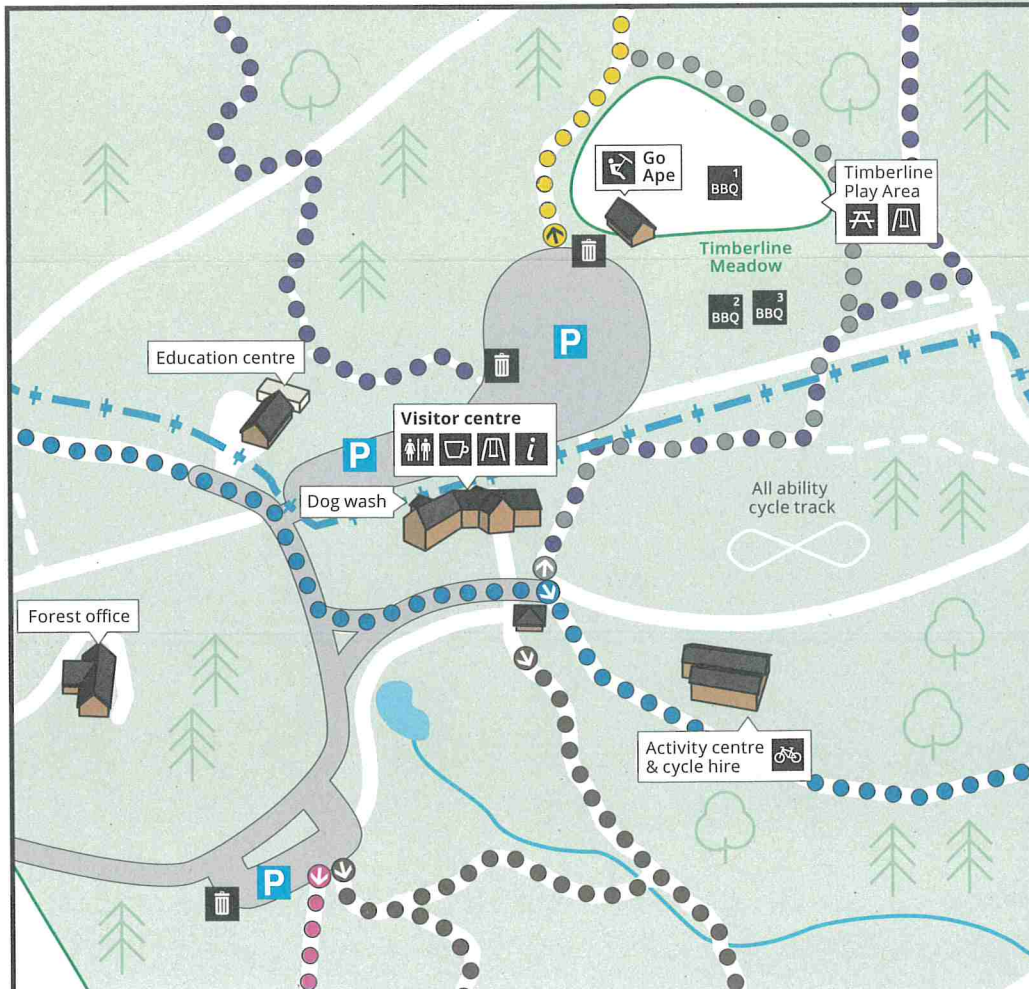
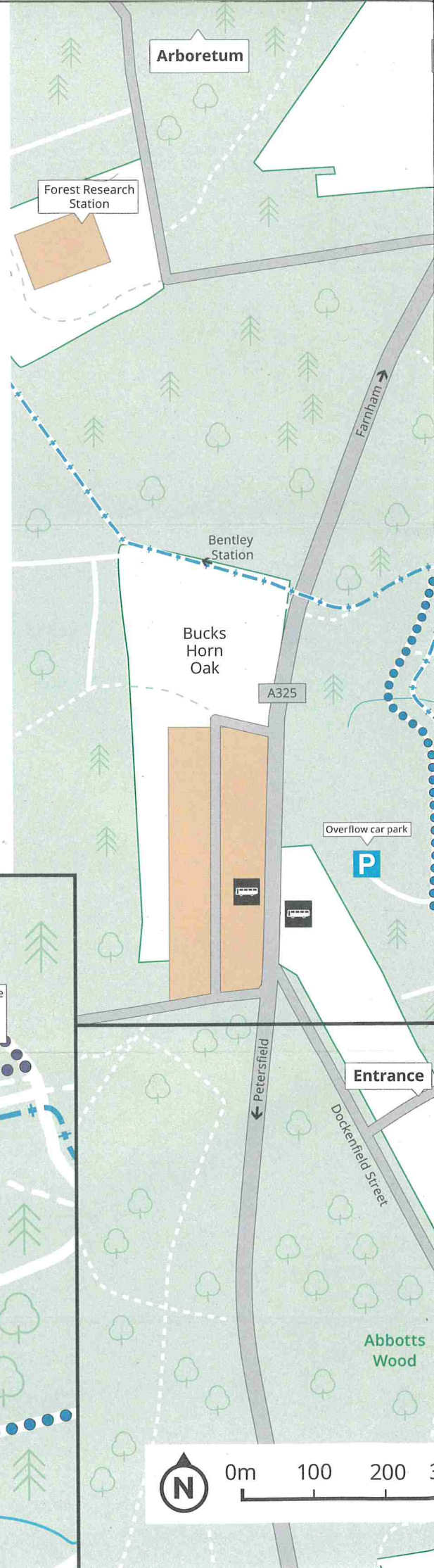
A more 'off-road' trail to Lodge Pond, muddy in places but very beautiful.

5 km (3 miles)

A relatively easy ride around the forest with some steep hills.

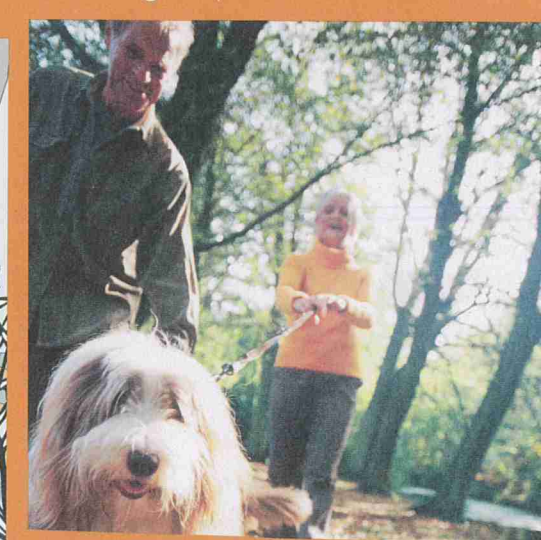
Forest code
