
FIRST STEPS – GETTING STARTED

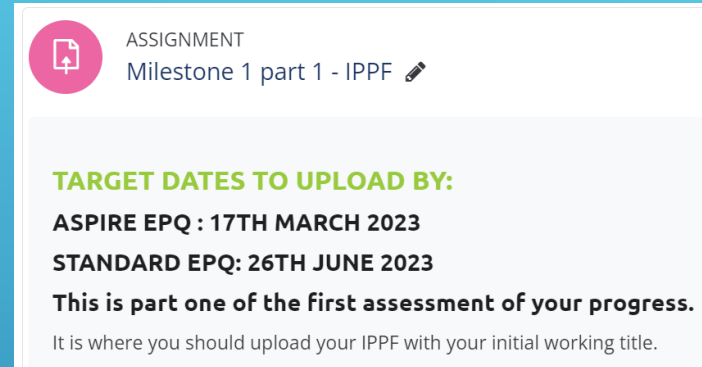

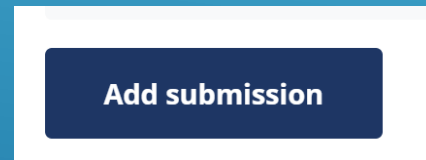

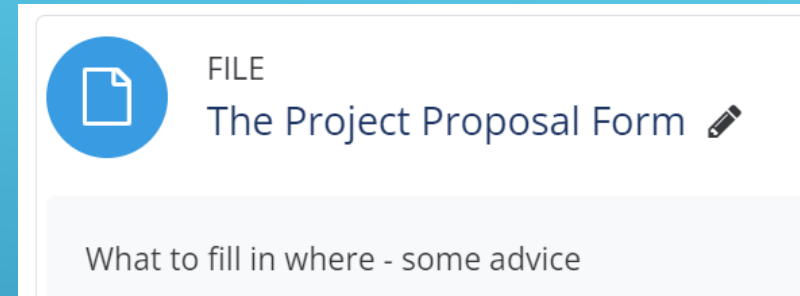
