Setting up a Poll on a GoL page

Example of what a Poll block looks like when someone has voted:

How to set up a Poll:

- 1. Turn editing on.
- 2. In the right column of the page in ADD A BLOCK add a Poll.
- 3. Click the Poll edit icon and choose **Configure Poll block**.
- 4. Add a name for the block it can be something general like **"What do you think?"** set the graph width to **200** and save changes. This block can be used for any number of Polls but only one at a time.
- 5. Now edit the Poll block again and click **Create/Edit Poll**.
- 6. Give your Poll a name, add the question and choose how many options. **Save changes.** You also have the option of checking the **Anonymous** check box (see below).
- 7. Add your options and **save changes** (see below).
- 8. Now choose the **Configure Block** tab and set the **Poll name** to the poll you have set up and save changes.
- 9. Your poll is ready to use and will display on the course page. When a student has voted they will be able to see how everyone else has voted so far.
- 10. You can hide the Poll block when you have finished using it or set up another poll to display in the same block.
