How to Make a Cinemagraph

- 1. In photoshop go Window Workspace Video
- 2. Go Window tick animation if not already ticked
- 3. Shoot some moving image on your camera.
- 4. In photoshop open the file.
- 5. File Export Render Video
- 6. Close the image you have open in photoshop
- 7. File Import Video Frames to Layers


8. Select Layer 1 in layers palette and click on the 'Unify Layer Visibility' button.




9. Delete layers you don't want. You can edit your movie before importing it or you can simply delete the layers in photoshop. The more layers you keep the more work you give yourself. To start with reduce the animation to just 10 layers.




10. Highlight layer 2 and create a layer mask. Use the black and white paint brushes on the layer mask to determine which parts of the layer you wish to see move.



11. Repeat for all layers



12. Select all of the animation layers and select the time for the frames.



13. Go File - Save for web and devices. Make sure you select the GIF option then save.
