

LABORATORY RULES

1. **Lab coats** must be worn when specified and any supplementary instructions from the supervising tutor must be adhered to.
2. Exposed septic cuts and sores caused before or during the lesson must be reported to the teacher and covered.
3. **Safety goggles** must be worn when heating liquids or handling hazardous chemicals and hair tied back if necessary.
4. On no occasion should food, drink or any other item be placed into your mouth during the course of the lesson.
5. Always work tidily and move around the lab in a responsible and safe manner. Put all bags under the bench.
6. Any spillage or breakage must be reported to the teacher immediately. Do not attempt to clear it up.
7. Put waste solid in correct bin **not** down the sink.
8. Hands must be washed thoroughly in hot soapy water after handling biological material or chemicals.
9. Report any accidents to the teacher. This includes burns or cuts and chemicals in the mouth, the eyes or on the skin.
