2. What do you consider to be the most important colour in this painting in terms of composition?
3. Can you identify any colour harmonies in this work?
4: El Greco has placed two primary colours and their secondary colour in this work. Can you locate them? Why might he have done this?
5: Compare the upper half of the canvas with the lower half. How are the figures painted? Look at flesh tones, costumes, setting.
6: How does El Greco connect the physical world with the spiritual world in this painting?
7: Some <u>forms</u> are specifically coloured throughout the composition, likewise particular <u>objects</u> are given the same colour. Can you identify them?
